Please provide a copy of this report as I have not been able to locate it on the DCC website, where it should be published.

This document should be easily retrievable so please provide it as a matter of urgency. There can be no reason to justify a delay in the provision of this particular document. Please also provide any similar reports that have been commissioned by DCC regarding the viability or other wise of the golf course. I am happy to have staged disclosure for the additional information but require the time limits are adhered to in respect of the report identified at 4.26
